

HOW TO VOTE BY MAIL

IN IOWA FOR THE NOVEMBER 2020 ELECTION

Election Day is Tuesday, November 3. There are different ways to cast your vote, but voting by mail can be done without having to go out.

1 ARE YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE?

Before you vote by mail, you have to be registered.

If you recently moved from a different state or even a different address, you will have to register to vote or update your registration in Iowa.

You can go online and check to see if you're registered at www.tinyurl.com/AmlRegisteredIA.

Otherwise, you can call your county auditor's office. (See below.)

2 FILL OUT A BALLOT REQUEST FORM.

This asks for an "absentee" ballot to be mailed to you. There is one printed on the back of this flier.

This request form MUST be received by your county auditor by Saturday, October 24. Be sure to give it plenty of time to get there.

3 YOU'LL THEN RECEIVE THE ACTUAL BALLOT IN THE MAIL.

Fill it out and mail it to your county auditor's office.

It MUST be postmarked no later than Monday, Nov. 2, 2020. Election Day is Nov. 3.
