Under Iowa Code Chapter 22 I request the following public records:

1. Copies of all written correspondence (including but not limited to emails, mailed or hand-delivered letters, faxes, text messages, messages on an Apple Watch or instant messaging system) to Governor Kim Reynolds or staff in the governor's office asking the governor to sign or veto Division XXXIII of House File 2643, relating to electric transmission lines.

2. Copies of memos or staff summaries of telephone messages left for the governor or her staff, regarding the same part of House File 2643 on transmission lines.

For this search, please use the time frame of June 13, 2020 to June 30, 2020, and the keywords "transmission" or "electric" or "utilities" or "Division 33" or "Division XXXIII" or "Section 128."

To reduce printing and photocopying costs and to facilitate social distancing, I request that these records be provided in electronic format.
